All Aussie Skate entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate Failure to comply with membership requirements will result in withdrawal from the event. Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.		
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. In connection with this event. Withdrawals	Partial refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw . No refund permitted after the draw. A 20% administration fee may be deducted from the refund. This condition continues to apply if a competitor withdraws for a reason other than those covered under the special Covid Conditions Special Covid Conditions If a border closure, lockdown or other government directive as above, requires withdrawal more than 2 weeks before the event, a full refund will be provided If the border closure or lockdown requires withdrawal within the two-week period, an administration fee of 20% may be deducted from the refund to cover the administration fees that have been incurred. Ice time can only be cancelled two weeks prior to the event which is why a full refund might not be possible. The value of the refund will be determined a week after the conclusion of the event to ensure the maximum amount can be returned to entrants impacted by COVID-19 restrictions. Other Music file notes	All competitors must have a backup copy of their competition music on USB available. Mobile phones will NOT be accepted for backup use. Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction. Each program (free skating, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.
PPC	Planned Program Content (PPC) forms for IJS divisions must be completed online as part of the entry process. If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete.

Schedule	A schedule of events will be provided following the closing of entries and published on the Melbourne Figure Skating Club website and Facebook Page. This schedule will be published subject to change based on entry numbers, including changes to event days. Interstate entrants are advised to consider travel insurance.

NOTES

EVENT REGISTRATION and VENUE ENTRY

Competitors must register **at least 1 hour** prior to their scheduled event.

The official Registration desk will be located at the main entrance adjacent to the Henke rink.

An admission fee per spectator is payable to O'Brien Icehouse at the front desk for each day of competition. Skaters will receive one Chaperone Pass for each event entered.

All attendees must adhere to local conditions which may include, but not be limited to;

- Wearing of masks indoors (unless there is a legal exemption)
- Limiting of attendees and spectators to the event
- Specific entry and exit times

- Checking in to the venue
- Follow all COVIDSafe directions provided by O'Brien Icehouse staff and the event COVIDSafe marshal/s

Anyone who refuses to adhere to the conditions may be required to leave the venue, and in the case of a competitor, not be allowed to compete.

A covid safe plan will be implemented during the competition which will include attestation that the competitor or other attendees have not been in a red zone, in a known exposure site or are awaiting the result of a Covid test.

Photography

An official photographer will be available at the event.

Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is permitted in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.

All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event.

Videography

Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information / Registration desk on the day of the event.
