Membership Requirements	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated/member club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association). Club names must be indicated in the entry.</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Upon competition online entry POAs (Proof of age) must be entered.</p> <p><i>Failure to comply with membership requirements will result in withdrawal from the event.</i></p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p>

The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
PPC	Planned Program Content (PPC) forms for IJS divisions must be completed online as part of the entry process. If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete.

TOI will receive a placing trophy and individual competitor medals.</p> <p>Crystal Challenge Perpetual Trophy The winner of the Crystal Challenge Perpetual trophy will be judged from the IJS Free Skating performances: Preliminary to Senior. They may be a skater from any club throughout Australia. The Crystal Challenge Perpetual Trophy is awarded to the skater whose attitude, performance and skating spirit stands out from the crowd, and embodies the spirit of this great sport ~ resilience, courage, expression and beauty of performance.</p>
